Watercolor Supply list

Students are welcome to use whatever they already have,
or buy a kit from Blick Art Store (on Broadway in Seattle, ask for Yulia's watercolor kit)
or use the following list:

Paper:

Black and Green cover Arches Watercolor Pad (NOT block!!!) any size
or 1(one) sheet of Arches Paper: 140#, 22x30", cold press

Paint:

Transparent Watercolor Pans Set - any brand *except Reeves*
(if have tubes, those should be squeeze onto a folding pallet with wells and dried,
similar colors next to each other, considering browns are "dirty" yellows)

Brushes (Two (2)):

1(one) round **pointed** #10 Synthetic Watercolor Brush

Best deal: Daiso WHITE NYLON ROUND 5 brushes set – quite a deal @\$1.50 if you can find it.
Flat white nylon brushes are good addition. Just make sure they all are WHITE NYLON

1(one) Sheep Hair 2" Hake Flat Brush

Graphite pencil (2B) & kneaded eraser
